Please ensure that both yourself and all players you are entering are available on the days shown for the classes you have entered before submitting your entry. The full printed Programme will be available from the end of July.

The Programme has been arranged so that all Finals can be completed by about 5.30 pm on Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> September. In the interest of time, there will be no trial ends during any of the games in the Tournament. See the separate rules for the Centenary Mixed Fours Competition (which carries <u>VERY ENHANCED PRIZE MONEY</u>) and the 'Aussie Pairs' and 'Bembridge' Mixed 2 Bowl Triples games.

Please remember that Lunches, Snacks and Teas will be available every day and a Licenced Bar will be open all-day to help you relax.

### 'AUSSIE PAIRS' FORMAT OF PLAY

**A 1 hour 'Round Robin' game.** (With a 2 hour semi and final.) **4 bowls** each. On the First End the LEAD bowler delivers two (2) of their four (4) bowls. This is then followed by the SKIP bowling all four (4) of their bowls. Finally the LEAD then bowls their remaining Two (2) Bowls completing the "end."

On the Second End the order of play is reversed. The SKIP now plays the Lead position and bowls two (2) of their four (4) Bowls. The LEAD player has now moved to being the Skip and bowls their four (4) Bowls. Finally the SKIP, who is still playing as the lead on this end, bowls their remaining two (2) bowls.

The format of reversing the playing positions is then continued throughout the game with the lead leading off on odd ends and the skip leading off on even ends.

### RULES FOR 'BEMBRIDGE' MIXED TRIPLES

**A 1 hour 'Round Robin' game.** (With a 2 hour semi and final.) **2 bowls** each. Three players make up a team with at least 1 player of both sexes per team. The team with the highest score in the allotted time wins.

**Scoring**: The players' bowl of either team closest to the jack scores 4 points, the next nearest 3 points, next 2 points and the fourth bowl 1 point (i.e. 10 available points per end). No other bowls score in that end. Any team member who <u>delivers</u> a jack <u>or</u> bowl outside of the playing area (including the ditch) forfeits that whole end for their team <u>and</u> the opposition is awarded 10 points. Jacks knocked into the ditch and 'touchers' in the ditch remain live.

Play ceases in all games with a bell at the end of the session and no other jack is to be delivered following the bell unless (in the Pairs and Fours) it has already been cast and returned. Skips may NOT visit the head until after the last bell.
